Regrettably, not all lawyers possess these skills. The Competition provides an opportunity for a valuable educational and cultural interchange between students, law teachers, and legal practitioners.

IN & AROUND THE CAMPUS

Campus Facilities

Internet Access

For those who wish to have Internet access, you are advised to bring your own laptop. You need to register your network card through us before you can connect to the HKU wireless campus network.

You will need to provide us with your full name, team name and Network Card address (also known as Ethernet address or MAC (Media Access Control) address).

If you do not know your Network Card address, please go to <http://www.hku.hk/cc/fac/register-nic.htm>.

You will need to provide these details on the first day of the competition during registration. If you fail to do so, internet access cannot subsequently be arranged. The Internet access will be available a few hours after the registration process is completed.

Library Service

You will receive a library pass giving you access to the Law Library which is situated in K K Leung Building. Access is from the Ground Floor.

Student Co-op Store

The Student Co-op is located at the Hsu Long Sing Amenities Centre (No. 17 on the HKU Campus Map). It sells stationery, souvenirs and computer accessories. It is opened for business from 9.00am to 6.00pm on Friday and from 9.00am to 12.00pm on Saturday.

University Bookstore

The University Bookstore is located at the Ground Floor of Run Run Shaw Building (No. 12 on the *HKU Campus Map*). It is opened from 9.00 to 7.00pm on Friday and from 9.30am to 1.00pm on Saturday.

Automated Teller Machine (ATM)

ATM machines are available outside the HSBC Bank at Run Run Shaw Building (No. 12 on the *HKU Campus Map*); the BEA Bank at Chong Yuet Ming Amenities Centre (No. 8 on the *HKU Campus Map*); and the Bank of China at the podium of Haking Wong Building (No. 16 on the *HKU Campus Map*). It provides instant cash access to funds to credit cards marked with Plus, Cirrus, Visa and Mastercard logos.

Catering Outlets

In the main campus, there are fast food restaurants offering a wide range of international cuisines, local foods and Chinese Dim Sum; and cafes where you can enjoy range of healthy food and freshly brewed coffee.

Telephone

Coin-operated telephones for local calls are available at Loke Yew Hall and at Room M200. You may wish to purchase a calling card from the convenience stores (eg Circle K, 7-11) located along Bonham Road (East Gate Entrance) for this purpose.

Taxi Services

The most common taxis you will see throughout the Hong Kong Island are the urban (red-coloured) taxis. It is generally easy to flag a taxi at Bonham Road (East Gate Entrance). Fares start from HKD 18 for the first 2km or part thereof. Each taxi is allowed a maximum of 5 passengers. Passengers shall pay the taxi fare as recorded by the taximeter and surcharge applies if the taxi is hired through a phone booking or the journey involves passing through a toll tunnel. There is also a surcharge for luggage (and “each animal or bird”)!
