Paul Lejot is a Visiting Fellow of the Asian Institute of International Financial Law at the University of Hong Kong and has been a director of Hong Kong-based Axia Capital Ltd since 1999, specialising in corporate advisory and restructuring. Lejot was formerly head of Asia-Pacific debt capital markets origination for ABN Amro Bank in Hong Kong and Singapore and has extensive regional experience in fixed income and corporate finance.

He has advised a wide range of public and private sectors borrowers throughout East and Southeast Asia, and has managed projects in private sector corporatisation; to create Asian money market funds; and to securitise Hong Kong residential mortgage loans.

Lejot's work at AIIFL is part of a new initiative to create a non-profit think tank at the university, concentrating on the public policy aspects of financial markets, financial product development and regulatory arbitrage and trade policy. He is the principal author of AIIFL's review of Asian debt capital markets published in October 2003 by the Hong Kong Institute for Monetary Research, and a forthcoming policy paper on medium-term market development
