

Pathways Programme with University of New South Wales (UNSW)

PROGRAMME INFORMATION

This programme is designed for single LLB students who wish to start on an LLM programme with the University of New South Wales before the completion of the LLB programme. The maximum annual intake of each programme is three students.

Student admitted in this programme will spend their first three and a half years studying at HKU. In their second semester of the fourth year, they will study for their LLM at UNSW. Upon successful completion of all course requirements at HKU and UNSW, these students will be awarded the LLB from HKU and the LLM from UNSW.

The curriculum structure is as follows:

ELIGIBILITY

LLB Year 2 students with a minimum CGPA of 3.5 (The nominees should also have a minimum CGPA of 3.5 at the end of the semester prior to departure) and have completed a summer programme offered by the University (can be in law or non-law subjects) in the summer vacation between Year 1 and Year 2 of their studies.
