1. The fees are for the standard courses offered by Hertford. Additional fees are charged for biochemistry, computer science, physics, and experimental psychology. The additional fees range from £398 to £1,277 per term depending on subject. Some courses require students to remain in Oxford for longer than the standard term of 8 weeks and 3 days.

2. The fees include:
 - a) Tuition fees and college charges.** This covers provision of University Card, tutorial arrangements, teaching costs, attendance at University lectures and departmental seminars, access to college, faculty and Bodleian libraries, membership of the JCR and MCR, access to College sports facilities clubs and societies, University sports facilities, clubs and societies, computing facilities and provision of transcripts.
 - b) Provision of furnished single study bedroom** including bedding and facilities for the duration of the programme. Visiting students no longer need to vacate their rooms in the vacation or pay vacation rent.
 - c) Meals taken in Hertford College dining hall** are paid for on a "pay as you go" basis and the amount of each meal is deducted from the student's **meal allowance**. Additional meals taken above the allowance will be charged to the student's account which are payable before the student departs. There is no rebate if the meal allowance has not been used.
3. Unless otherwise agreed under the terms of the MOU there is a 10% non-refundable deposit payable once the student has formally accepted their place.
