1. The fees are for the standard courses offered by Hertford. These are the humanities, the social and political sciences and human sciences. University fees for some of the hard science subjects and for geography and music have increased very substantially in the past few years. Please see the chart below for the higher programme fee levels for students wishing to do tutorials in these subjects.

2. The Programme fees include:

- a) Tuition fees and college charges. This covers provision of University Card, tutorial arrangements, teaching costs, attendance at University lectures and departmental seminars, access to college, faculty and Bodleian libraries, membership of the JCR and MCR, access to College sports facilities clubs and societies, University sports facilities, clubs and societies, computing facilities and provision of transcripts.
- **b) Accommodation** in a furnished **single study bedroom** including bedding and facilities for the duration of the programme. Visiting students attending for the full academic year or for two consecutive terms do not need to vacate their rooms in the vacation or pay vacation rent if they choose to remain in Oxford over the vacation.
- **c) Meals** taken in Hertford College dining hall are paid for on a "pay as you go" basis and the amount of each meal is deducted from the student's **meal plan allowance**, which is on UPay. Once, and if, the allowance is used up students can pay for additional meals by topping up their UPay account. There is no rebate if the meal allowance has not been used at the end of each term. The meal plan covers a breakfast and one main meal during the week and brunch at the weekend. It also covers a couple of formal meals per term.
