REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR THE PERIOD  
FROM MARCH 2025 TO FEBRUARY 2026

Dear Members,

This year has been a fruitful year for The University of Hong Kong Law Alumni Association (the “**Association**”) during which we have planned, executed and organised a wide range of events and activities for our members, students, as well as in collaboration with the Faculty of Law (the “**Faculty**”). Our efforts aim to foster connections, enhance alumni involvement and support the development of current students.

**HKU Alumni Day**

The 2025 HKU Alumni Day took place on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2025 (Sunday). The Association and the Faculty collaborated to host a pop-up souvenir store at the Main Building Promenade. In addition to offering souvenirs of the Association, we organised a charity sale featuring cookies from CUIT, a bakery run by a law alumna. All law alumni and Association members were also invited to participate in a photo-taking session outside the Main Building.

**Meet-the-Alumni Dinner**

The “Meet-the-Alumni” Dinner took place on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025 (Friday) at Club Lusitano, gathering 18 students and 8 alumni in four groups. Participating alumni expressed positive feedback, highlighting that the inviting atmosphere of the venue, combined with a favourable alumni-to-student ratio, greatly enriched the discussions. Students valued the opportunity to receive guidance and insights from alumni as they navigated their academic and professional journey. The event successfully created an engaging environment for networking and collaboration between current students and alumni.

**Wellbeing Activities**

**Healthcare Seminar**

The Healthcare Seminar, presented by Dr. So Tsz Him, was held on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 (Thursday) at Des Voeux Chambers, attended by 10 alumni. Dr. So

delivered an informative and engaging talk focused on maintaining health through daily habits and the incorporation of appropriate supplements, drawing on insights from both Western medicine and traditional Chinese medicine perspectives. Participating alumni appreciated Dr. So's insights into the crucial role dietary choices play in overall well-being. The event provided valuable knowledge that alumni can apply to enhance their health and lifestyle.

### Calligraphy Workshop

The Chinese Calligraphy Workshop, led by Ms. Katrina Mo, was held on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025 (Thursday) at Stevenson, Wong & Co, and attended by 12 alumni. Participants enjoyed a relaxing and enriching evening immersed in the art of Chinese calligraphy. Under Ms. Mo's guidance, participating alumni learned about the significance of various brush techniques and the cultural heritage behind this ancient art form. The meditative nature of calligraphy provided a good opportunity to unwind and focus, promoting mindfulness and stress relief.

### HKU Law Alumni Choir Concert “*Celebrating Love*”

The HKU Law Alumni Choir Concert, co-organised by the Association and the Faculty, titled “*Celebrating Love*”, was held on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2025 (Saturday) at the HKU Grand Hall. The event featured a talented full choir accompanied by an orchestra, consisting of vocalists and instrumentalists from among alumni, current students and staff of the Faculty. Under the leadership of Choir Chairman and Conductor, Mr. Jeffrey Sham, the concert showcased a delightful selection of love songs, carefully chosen to resonate with audience of all ages. In a memorable highlight, the President and Acting Dean of the Faculty were invited to join the choir on stage for the singing of the Law Anthem. The performances created an atmosphere of joy and nostalgia, connecting attendees across generations through the universal theme of love.

### Law Mentorship Programme 2025-26

As the Law Mentorship Programme was suspended in 2024-25 academic year due to the 55<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of the Faculty, it was made available to both year 1 and year 2 students this year. Thanks to the generous support of our alumni, a total of 59 mentors were recruited and successfully matched with 112 mentees.
